A PROGRAM OF POPE & YOUNG



To be eligible for entry into the Pope & Young's Records Program, an animal must have been taken:

- a. Entirely by the use of the bow and arrow (as defined by Pope and Young)
- b. In complete compliance with the controlling state/provincial game regulations
- c. In complete compliance with the club's Rules of Fair Chase
- d. And must meet or exceed the corresponding minimum score requirements for that category

PROCEDURE TO SUBMIT AN ENTRY

The following items are required to be submitted to Pope & Young for an animal to be considered for possible acceptance into the Records:

- 1. The scoring form (the original) completed by an Official Measurer of Pope & Young or the Boone & Crockett Club. The antlers, horns or skull (completely cleaned) must undergo a "drying period" of at least sixty (60) days, during which it must remain at room temperature and room humidity in an unaltered state, before official measurements can be taken.
- 2. A completed Fair Chase Affidavit
- 3. Three (3) photos of the antlers, horns or skull (a view from the front side, a view from the left side and a view from the right side). A field photo is also requested, if possible.
- 4. \$40.00 recording fee (made payable to Pope and Young)

MINIMUM POINT SCORE REQUIREMENTS

Under the heading of North American big game are the following species categories with their appropriate minimum entry score requirement (using the Boone & Crockett / Pope & Young scoring system). Geographic boundaries, as described in the publication **Boone and Crockett Club – Pope and Young Club Official Measurers Manual**, are established for the categories.
